

Overview/Qualifications:

The Board of Directors (BOD) are each members in good standing of both ICF Global and ICF Toronto Chapter (paid Activity Fee) whose goals are to work together on behalf of their membership to provide quality member events, create partnerships and alliances, increase coaching awareness, ensure fiscal responsibility, and deliver member value. Those who serve do so in a welcoming, inclusive environment that inspires learning and mentoring.

Each director is elected by the membership for a term of two years and the time commitment is a two-hour Board meeting each month, a four to five hour strategy meeting in person (or virtually) quarterly, and depending upon the role, approximately ten hours a month of supportive work on Board committees.
